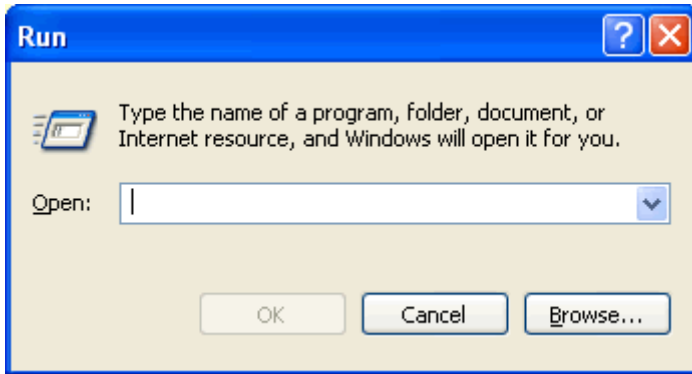
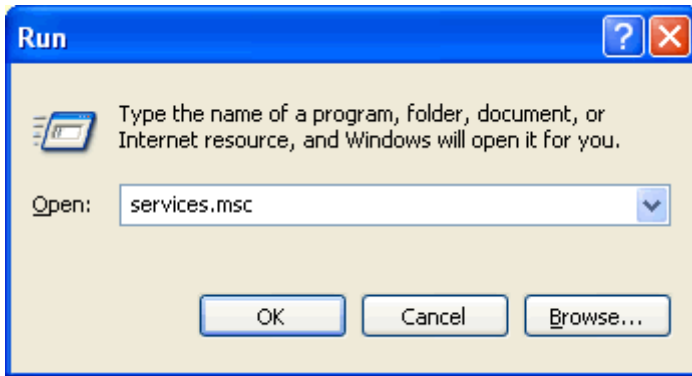

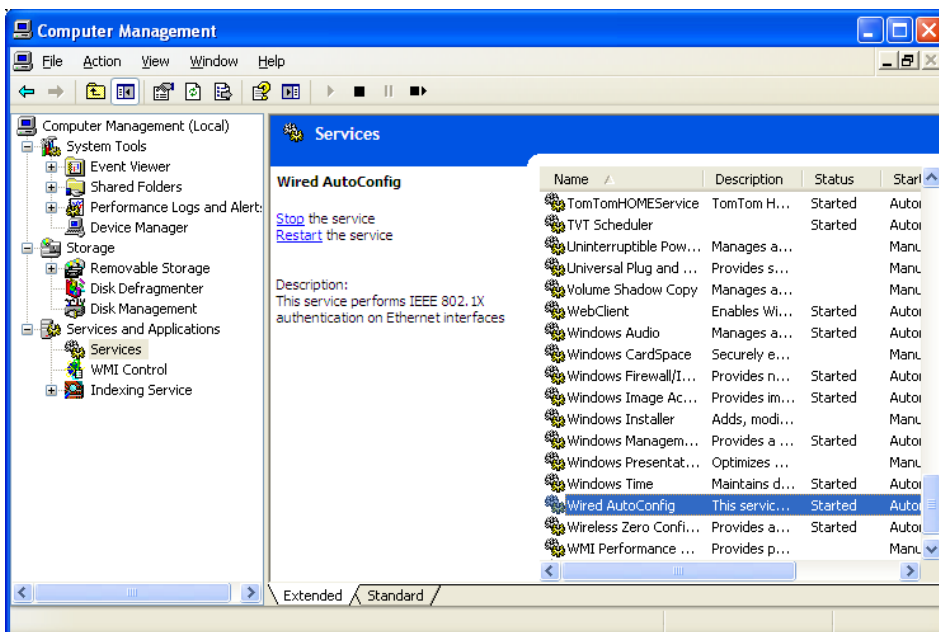
1. Press Start -> Run



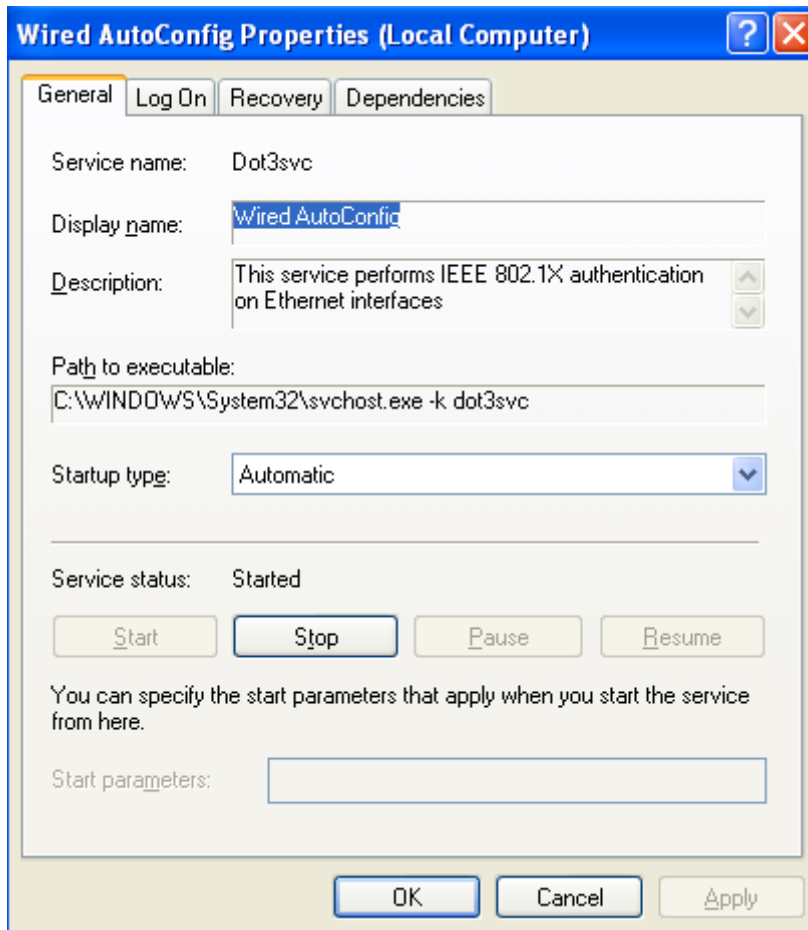
Enter services.msc



Press OK. Choose Wired AutoConfig

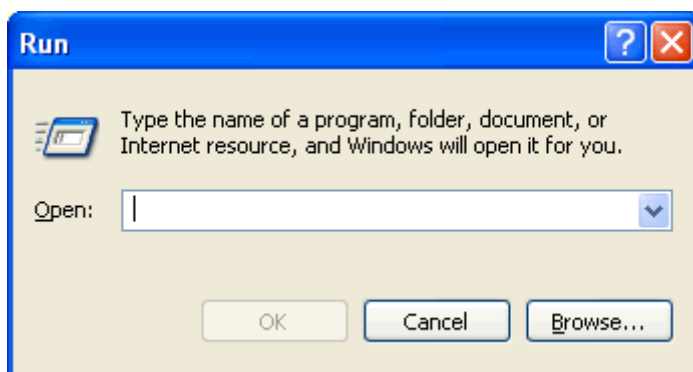


Choose automatic startup type (type - Automatic). Press Apply , Start, Ok



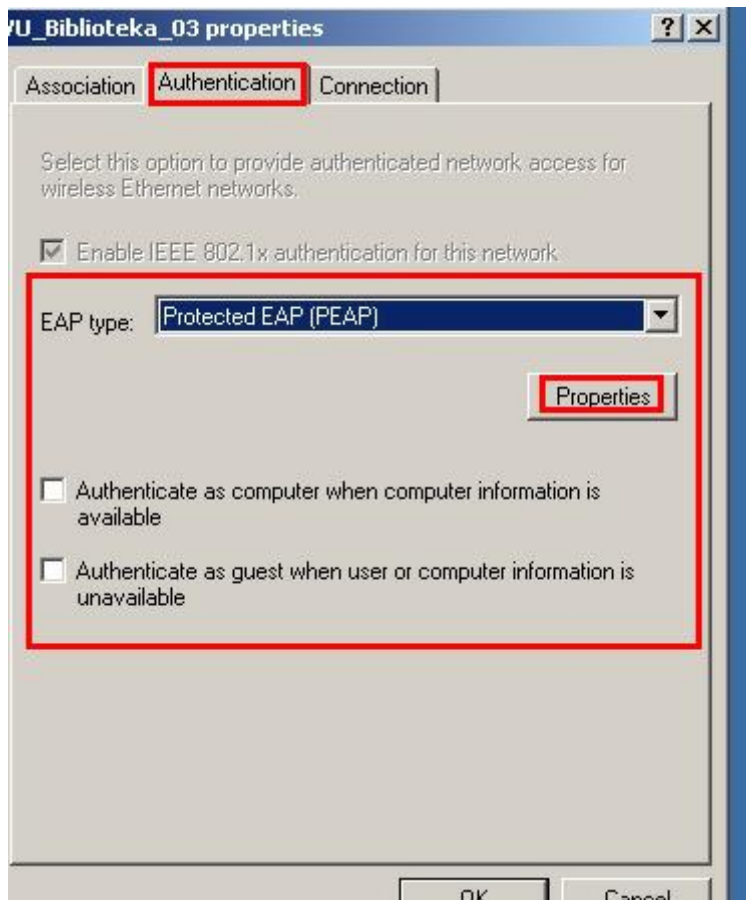
2. Prepare Protected EAP (PEAP)

Enter ncpa.cpl

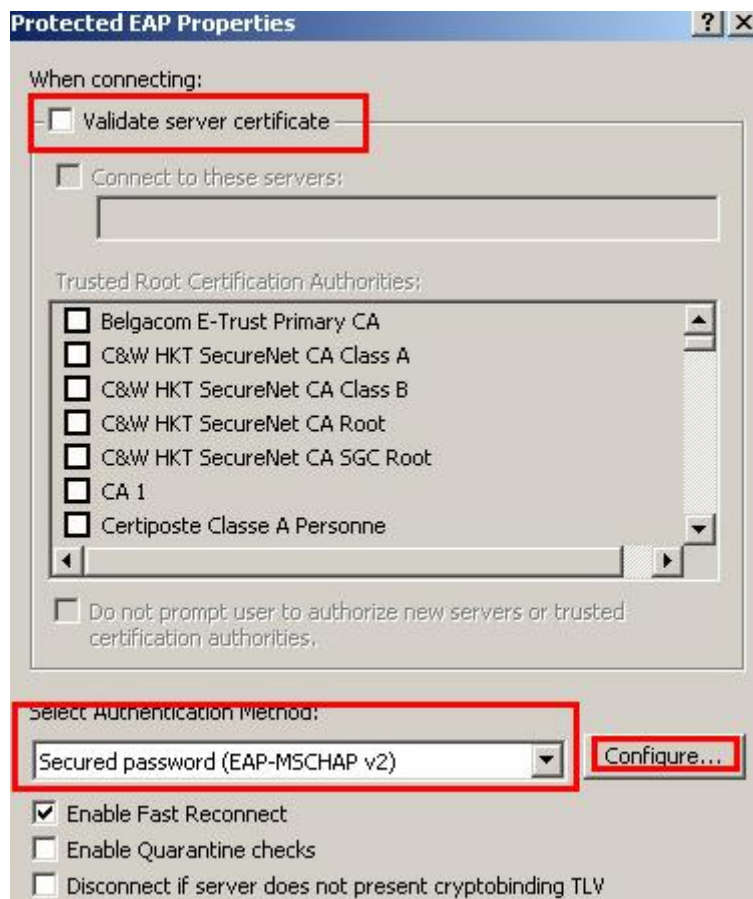
Press right mouse button on Local Area Connection ->Properties>Authentication



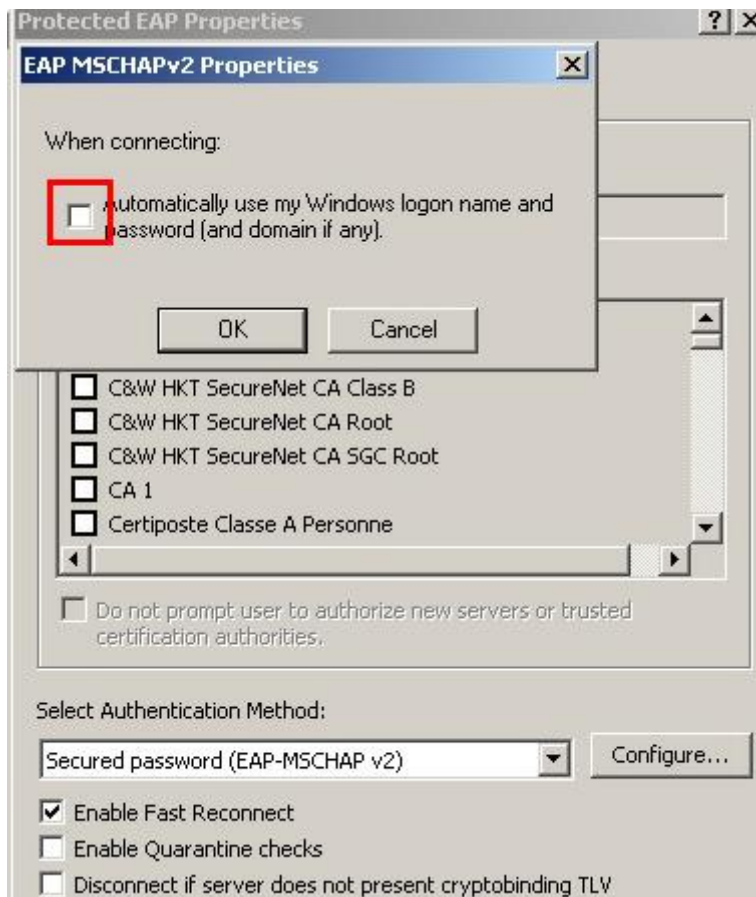
Choose – Authentication. Select EAP type – Protected EAP (PEAP).
